



Project Cope Level 1 Registration Form

Level I Project COPE is a series of increasingly difficult challenges and thrills on a trail in the woods. The challenges are designed to enhance group and individual traits such as self-esteem, decision-making, problem solving, trust, teamwork, communications, and leadership. Opportunity is provided for every participant to achieve success as an individual and as part of a team, and to have the thrill of a lifetime. A patch is provided to all participants.

Level I Project COPE is available at both Short-term Camp and Summer Camp by arrangement with the Camping Service.

This program is available for Boy Scouts who are at least 12 years of age, *or have completed the sixth grade*, by the date of participation. The cost of the course is \$125 (there must be a minimum of 8 persons), in addition to any camping fees. This COPE fee is waived for those participating while in attendance at summer camp. COPE fees must be paid with the Short-term Camping fees, and must be received no later than 30 days prior to attendance during the short-term season. There are no refunds of fees for cancellations within two weeks of program date.

The program includes elements with names like: Artesian Beams, Meatgrinder, Wild Woosey, Spider's Web, and the Wall.

Participants must wear long pants while on the course. Sneakers are the recommended footwear.

No physical examination by a licensed medical practitioner is required but an up to date Personal Health History or personal interview with the Course Instructor must be provided.

Project Cope Level 2 Registration Form

Project COPE (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience) is a high adventure program that consists of group initiative games, low and high course events, thrills and challenges. The seven goals of the course are to improve leadership skills, problem solving abilities, trust, teamwork, communications, and decision-making capabilities.

Opportunity is provided for every participant to achieve success as an individual and as a member of a team. COPE events are not planned to be competitive or a race against time. The events are designed to challenge the individual to realize his or her own unique capabilities. At the time of course graduation, each participant will receive a Project COPE T-shirt and patch as a reminder of this fantastic experience.

Level II COPE is offered to Scouts who are at least 13 years, old by January 1 of the year of participation, *or have completed the seventh grade*. The information below must be completed for all participants. The signature of a parent or guardian acknowledging participation is required for all participants under 18 years of age.

A valid Class I & II Personal Health History and Physical Examination Form is required of all participants less than 40 years of age. A valid Class III Personal Health History and Physical Examination Form is required of all participants 40 years old and older.

COPE programs are available on Short-term weekends by arrangements with the Camping Service. The COPE fee is \$25.00 per person (minimum \$375.00) and must be sent with any Short-term camping fees at least 30 days prior to participation during the short-term season. There are no refunds of fees for cancellations within two weeks of program date. The COPE fee is waived for those participating while in attendance at summer camp.

Participants must wear long pants while on the course. Sneakers are the recommended footwear.
